

TOWN TROLLEY SERVICE Get across town with stops at Snowcreek Athletic Club, Minaret Village Shopping Center, The Village and Canyon Lodge every 20 minutes in peak season. The open-air Lakes Basin Trolley leaves The Village for the Mammoth Lakes Basin every 30 minutes (peak days), stopping at most of the lakes in the Lakes Basin and providing access to area hiking trails. Also tows a 16-bike trailer for access to cycling.

The Mammoth Transit summer system operates from May 23 through November 20, 2015 and offers a convenient, fun and friendly alternative to getting around Mammoth Lakes. Passengers ride for free on all fixed routes in Town. The Dial-A-Ride service requires a fare and is available to all riders, with priority given to special needs passengers. Whether for work or play, we have a ride for you!

REDS MEADOW AND DEVILS POSTPILE NATIONAL MONUMENT

Visitors to Reds Meadow and Devils Postpile this summer can begin their adventure from The Village. The shuttle will operate Memorial Day Weekend and then from June 13 through September 9, 2015. The shuttle provides a convenient option for guests with service from The Village (Canyon Blvd. stop) every 45-60 minutes beginning at 7:15 A.M. with the last bus departing The Village (Canyon Blvd. stop) at 4:30 P.M. In addition to the departures from The Village, the Reds Meadow Shuttle operates from the Adventure Center at Main Lodge from 7:30 A.M. until 7 P.M. with service every 20 minutes from 10 A.M. until 4 P.M. Passengers returning to The Village can either ride the complimentary Bike Park Shuttle from the Main Lodge (last bus departs 4:45 P.M.), or catch the Reds Meadow Shuttle to The Village (last bus departs Reds Meadow at 7:45 P.M.).

VILLAGE TRANSPORTATION HUB

The Town Trolley, MAS Bike Shuttle, Lakes Basin Trolley, Reds Meadow Shuttle and the Purple Line all connect at The Village.

DOGS

Dogs are a fun part of Mammoth's mountain environment and are permitted on the Mammoth Transit System. For the safety and peace of mind of all passengers, dogs must be leashed and muzzled, or carried in a cage.

MAS BIKE SHUTTLE

The Mammoth Area Shuttle (MAS) is operated by Mammoth Mountain Ski Area for access to the Mammoth Bike Park at the Main Lodge. Pedestrians can ride to and from the Main Lodge as space is available. Paid Mountain Bike Park riders have seating priority.
