Regarding public input and comment on the Walk-Bike-Ride plan currently in development and being considered by the Council I would like to interject the very important and (to my knowledge), up until now, omitted skateboard mode of transportation.

I would urge the Council, Town and Planning Contractors to consider a Walk-Bike-Ride-Skate plan, so as to functionally factor in one of the already most-utilized modes of non-motorized transportation within town limits. As this form of transit will continue to contribute largely to local non-motorized transportation in the future, it would behoove the Council and Town to ensure its functional integration with other modes of non-motorized transit.

While skate culture is not known for its engagement in public process, it is our job as planners and citizens to think realistically about the needs of our citizenry. The Council, Town and Planners would be remiss to neglect this large proportion of the constituency and such a large part of the culture that defines the town itself.
